Proposed Rule Changes

Rule C2 - a score of possible 3 3's to be given to positions 5/6 if players in those positions score less than 3 - this will be amended to apply to Division 2 teams only rather than both Divisions 1 and 2. This was passed by a majority vote.

Rule C2 – full names to be put on signing on sheet and a minimum of first initial and surname on the match sheets.

Results are to be notified to Steve Sheldon by midnight after the match has been played otherwise a £2 fine will apply. Score sheets are still to be sent to Steve within 72 hours, this has not changed.

Competitions will continue to be played on Monday nights rather than Wednesday nights - voted unanimously

Cup Finals – majority vote to allow 3 balls per man practice in KO Cup and Competition (Singles, Pairs and Fives) cup finals – instead 1 ball per man.
